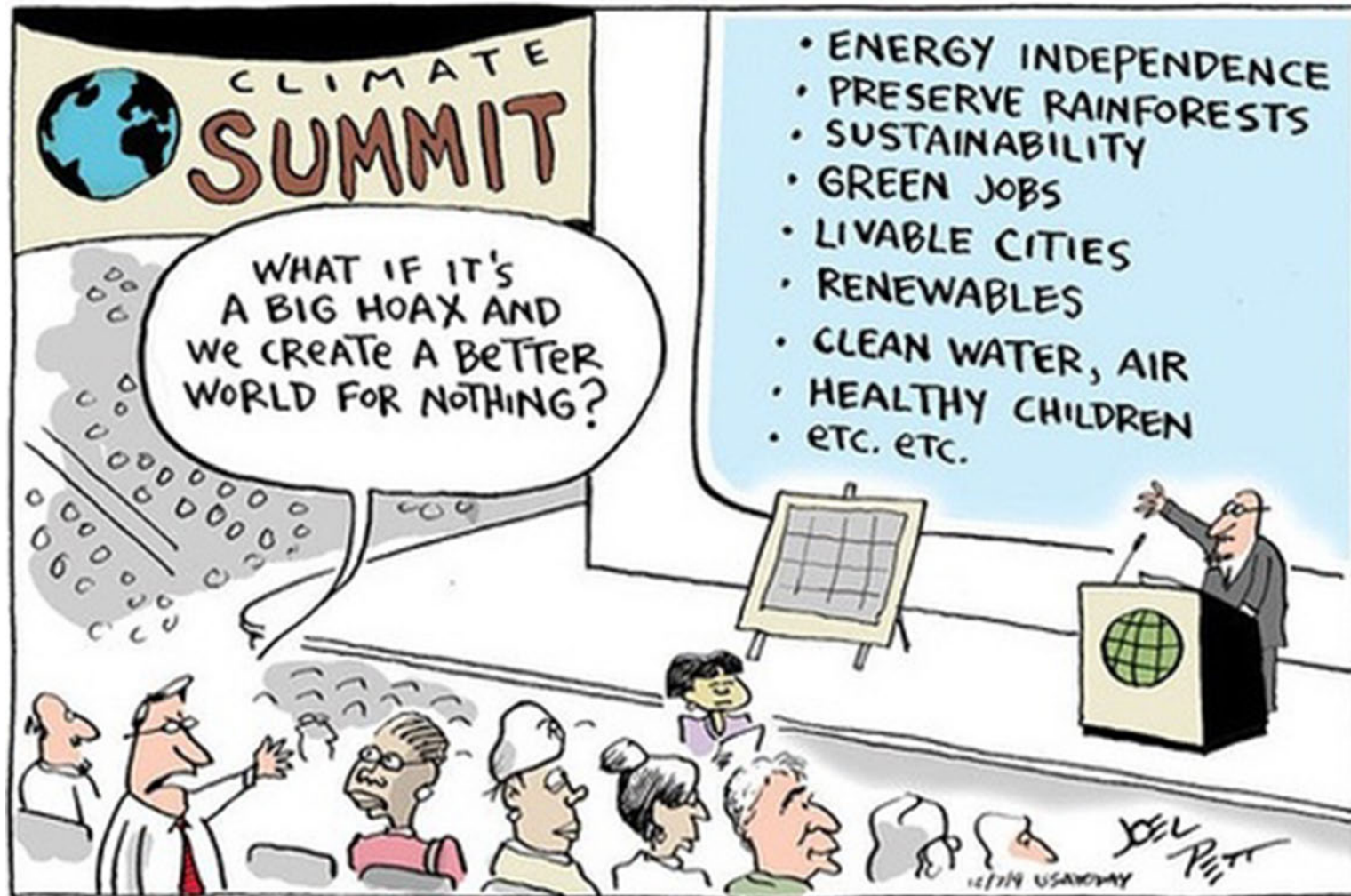


PSYC 193 (B00): Psychology of Climate Change
